- Module 4: Growth and Success, covering topics including growth strategies and sales, marketing your business, and a panel discussion of success stories with current American Water suppliers.
- Module 5: Prime Supplier Engagement, covering topics including subcontractor opportunities and a supplier site visit.
- Module 6: American Water Leaders Round Table, covering topics including leadership styles and business management strategies.

New Jersey American Water is actively recruiting minority-owned, woman-owned, LGBTQ+-owned, disability-owned, or veteran-owned business enterprises. The company will prioritize businesses with experience in water and wastewater including underground construction, pipeline replacement and additional areas of utility experience.
