- Payment Arrangements: If customers are unable to pay their bill by the due date, they can visit <u>MyWater</u> to review payment plan options or contact Iowa American Water's customer service center at 866-641-2108 before the due date to work with them to determine payment arrangements that may be available.
- Budget Billing: A free service that is available to eligible residential customers that provides fixed monthly payments over a period of 12 months, based on the customer's anticipated annual billing. The program makes managing your cash flow easier by providing predictable monthly payments and avoiding seasonal spikes that may be difficult to pay when not planned for in advance.
